What is the Kohl's Southeast Wisconsin Breast Health Assistance Fund?

This fund provides financial assistance to uninsured and underinsured individuals in Southeast Wisconsin who are at or below 400% of the federal poverty level. Assistance is provided for screening and diagnostic breast health services (i.e., mammograms, clinical breast exams, diagnostic mammograms, ultrasounds, and biopsies).

- ✓ Residents of Southeast Wisconsin counties (Jefferson, Kenosha, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine, Walworth, Washington, and Waukesha)
- ✓ Uninsured or underinsured individuals
- ✓ Those whose income is at or below 400% of the Federal Poverty Level
